Getting to Dundee

Dundee is 60 miles north of Edinburgh and linked with regular train and bus services from Edinburgh Airport. The Edinburgh Tram connects the Airport to Edinburgh Haymarket Station.

Dundee Tay Bridge railway station is by the waterfront in the heart of Dundee, directly opposite the new **V&A Museum**, a five minute walk to the **Apex** hotel and approximately 10 minutes from the University of Dundee. Trains from London also run direct to Dundee. (6 hours)
